- To incorporate data visualization to fuel better decision-making regarding the library website.



Questions



- Finding data
- Gathering data
- Cleaning data
 - Data checking
 - Data tabulation
 - Data integration
 - Variable naming
- Data sets
 - Recent 5 years of 7 digital spaces/contents usage and recent 4 years of student enrollment
 - Recent 5 years of top 10 QCL website content page views


Data Visualization

- Importing cleaned data into Tableau
- Identifying variables' data types
- Creating data viz sheets with appropriate tools/functions, for example:
 - Charts (bar, line, area, etc.)
 - Filters and Colors
 - Reference line
 - Dual Axis
 - Synchronize Axis
- **Generating dashboards**
 - Title, Axes, Legends


Data Viz Dashboards

4. Five-year trends of QCL digital content views


Five-Year Trends of QCL Website and Homepage Views (2018 - 2022)




QCL Website Views with OneSearch Primo Sessions and Student Enrollment Over Years

Findings

- The usage of the QCL website dropped off dramatically in the initial period of the COVID-19 pandemic and has slowly rebounded
- The use of OneSearch steadily increased over the years, even during the pandemic period
- Library website views did not correlate significantly with other library content views (e.g., LibGuides, E-Reserves, etc.), while the homepage usage significantly correlated with website usage
- The peak use of all library digital spaces was the library website in 2019, before the COVID-19 pandemic
- Some top 10 content webpages were removed over the years

Conclusion

- The use of OneSearch was not significantly impacted by the pandemic, which implies that a well-functional library online catalog is the most robust library resource supporting academic teaching and research during all times
- The backbone supporting the use of library website is the homepage.
- Because the library website was the main portal for library resources and services before the pandemic and is currently rebounding, we expect that it would regain this role in the future
- The discontinuity of some top 10 content webpage suggested that the website structure may need to be optimized
