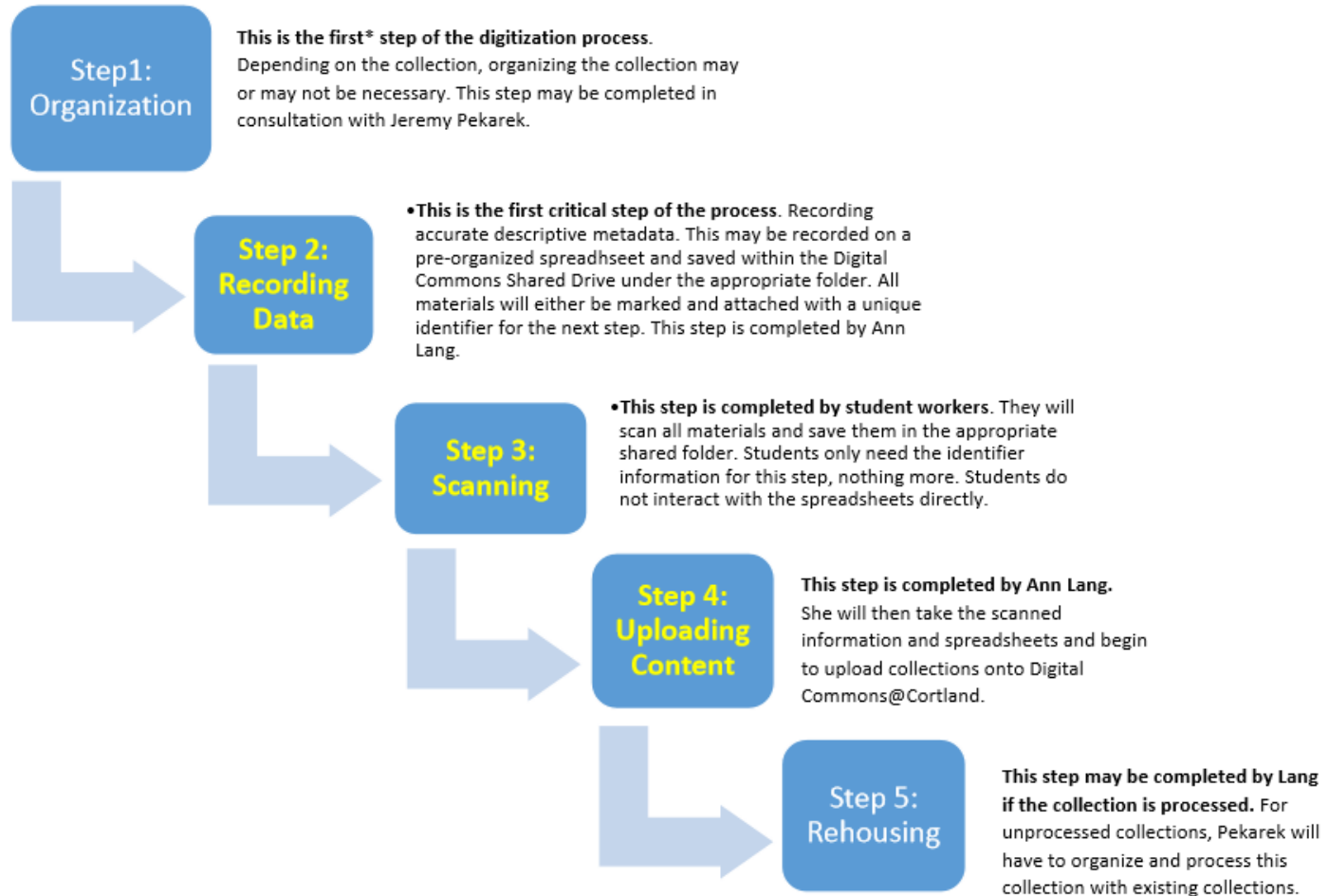

- Workflow is managed by Theses Coordinator and a Visiting Librarian
- Current theses are in Digital Commons
- Older theses are in Dspace, and will eventually be migrated

Journal Request

- Faculty request for an OA journal 'website' in July 2019
- Digital Commons has functionality needed to handle a peer-reviewed OA journal
- Reviewed other SUNY journals on SUNY Research Commons

Journal of the Scholarship of Engagement (JoSE)



Digital Commons Team

Team was created to prepare for future growth

Assumed JoSE would lead to influx of new requests

Reached out to SUNY colleagues to determine practical workflows

Transformations



- Undergraduate Research Conference
- Model of SUNY Brockport
- Hilary already on Transformations Committee

Info gathering

Workflows (one librarian uploads submissions, adds metadata)

Permissions waivers (permission to publish)

Showed drafts and examples to Transformations Committee

The Plan

- Voluntary, opt-in, no login needed
- Need faculty mentor's approval (concern from Sciences)
- Hilary would upload
- Posters only

Enter COVID-19

- Digital Commons *became* Transformations
- Included posters, slides, and papers
- Still opt-in, still need faculty member's approval.

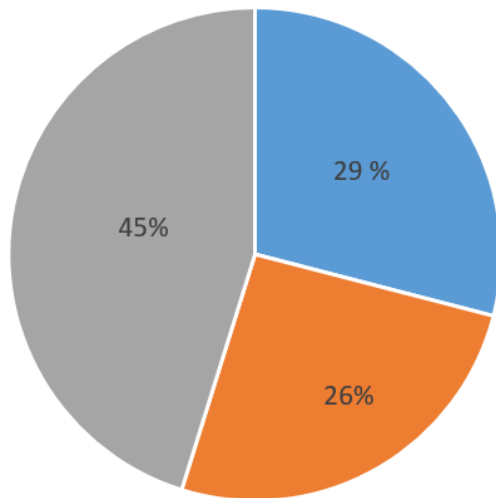

Participation and Distribution

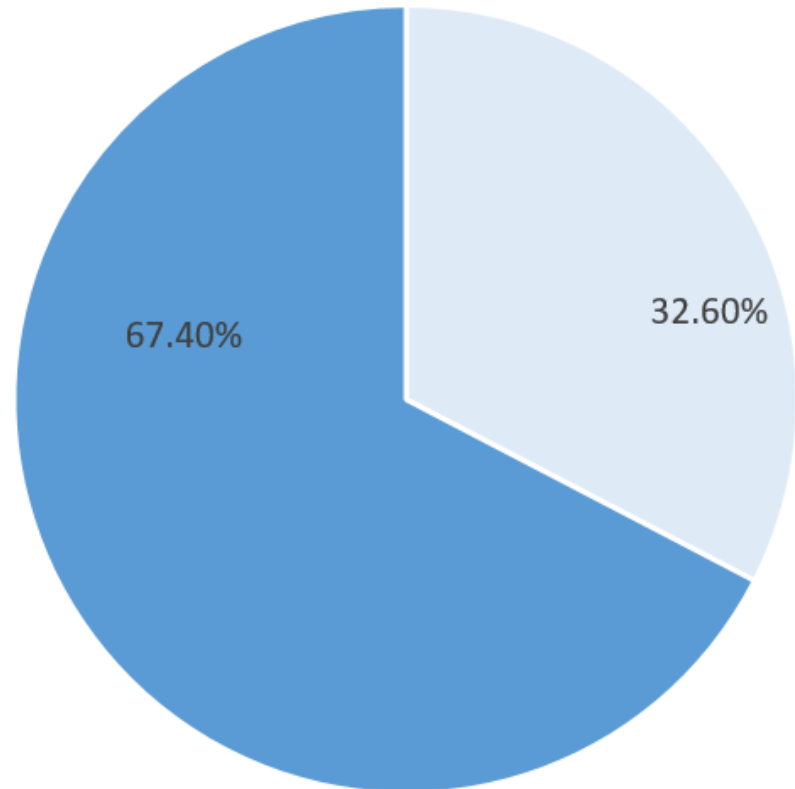
- 341 downloads
